Type of examination

schrP	written examination	The written examination is a written exam lasting 90-120 minutes.
mdIP	Oral examination	The oral examination is an interview lasting 15-20 minutes per student. The oral examination can be conducted as an individual or group examination.
StA	Student research project	The student research project is a term paper without an oral presentation. A term paper can be written using a word processing programme or as a presentation. A term paper comprises a minimum of 3000 to a maximum of 6000 words (word processing programme approx. 10 to 20 pages or presentation: approx. 15 to 20 pages).
SA	Seminar paper	The seminar paper is a term paper with an oral presentation. The oral presentation lasts a total of 15 minutes per student and can also take place during the semester. A term paper can be written using a word processing programme or as a presentation. It comprises a minimum of 3000 to a maximum of 6000 words (word processing programme: approx. 10 to 20 pages or presentation: approx. 15 to 20 pages).
Proj	Project work	The project work is joint group work in which several students work on a joint task as a team and present the results orally and in writing. Each student must contribute individually to the joint assignment and deliver an oral presentation lasting 15 minutes. The written part has a total length of approx. 10-20 pages.
MA	Master's Thesis	Written thesis in the Master's Thesis programme: Maximum processing time (= period between registration of the Master's Thesis and submission) of 9 months / length 60 to 80 pages (excluding cover sheets, indexes and appendices) created with a word processing programme. Coll	Colloquium	The colloquium is an oral examination lasting 10-15 minutes in which the student defends the results of his or her thesis.
